

# Instructions for wear checks of play equipment

The equipment must be checked for correct operation and safety, especially the points listed below:

Proof of maintenance



Checks depend on the type of equipment. Any equipment with moving parts must be checked at least twice a year, static equipment at least once a year.

Intervals for maintenance work and checks generally depend on

- location
- usage
- frequency of use
- possible vandalism

**Pedal Pump**  
for external sprayhead  
**Order No. 5.18230**



## Function

1. Carry out an operational test to ensure the pump mechanism moves smoothly.
2. Ensure that cranks and pedals are securely connected and check for proper operation.
3. Check saddle for wear and tear and ensure it is securely connected.

## Water supply

4. Check hoses for wear and tear, replace if necessary after removing the service lid (located on the side) and the crank.
5. Check water supply for wear and tear, and clean the suction filter if necessary.

### Note

The connecting line as well as the external sprayhead may be third-party products (not included in delivery of the pedal pump). The maintenance steps described under 6. and 7. are recommended nonetheless. However, any separate maintenance notes should be prioritised.

6. Check that the connecting line to the external sprayhead allows for a proper flow rate and is tight.
7. Check that the external sprayhead is fully operational and clean if necessary.

## Structural stability

8. Check anchoring to the ground once a year, retighten screws and bolts if necessary.

### Note

Prior to the start of the frost period, turn off water supply and drain the lines, dismantle the pedal pump and drain the water container if necessary. If the pedal pump has been removed, you can close the opening using the included winter lid.









Special notes, e.g. for repairs

Repair not carried out, equipment is taken out of action


