


<h2>Instructions for wear checks of play equipment</h2>	<p>The equipment must be checked for correct operation and safety, especially the points listed below:</p>	<p>Proof of maintenance</p>

<p>Checks depend on the type of equipment. Any equipment with moving parts must be checked at least twice a year, static equipment at least once a year.</p> <p>Intervals for maintenance work and checks generally depend on</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- location</li> <li>- kind of use</li> <li>- frequency of use</li> <li>- possible vandalism</li> </ul>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Check for rot and, if necessary, smooth splinters and round off sharp edges of cracks.</li> <li>2. Check that all screws and wood connections are tight and retighten if necessary.</li> <li>3. <b>Recommendation:</b> apply paraffin wax to the upper end grain areas once a year, please refer to Order No. 0.90100, 1 litre.</li> </ol> <p>Structural stability</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>4.
