
**Fundamental characteristics**

**Recommended for**


- School children

Two-part plate made of polymer concrete, 30 mm

Surface absolutely weatherproof, smooth, does not reflect sunlight, enables precise, fast and quiet play

Edges made of shatter-proof hardened PVC, 45 mm

Substructure made of polymer concrete

Net and fixings made of 4 / 8 mm aluminium

Standard colour green, optionally available in blue and anthracite on request.
